**2012 Petit Chablis - Hautérivien**

A markedly ripe nose features notes of peach and apricot that leads to lush, indeed even opulent flavor that possess fine concentration, all wrapped in a seductively textured if ever-so-slightly warm finish. This is atypical for the appellation but not without a certain appeal. Note that this could already be enjoyed.

**2012 Chablis**

A fresher and cooler nose offers up bright aromas of pear, green fruit and oyster shell along with plenty of Chablis character. The rich, detailed and vibrant flavors exude a fine bead of minerality on the saline, balanced and solidly persistent finish. This is worth checking out as it's very good for its level.

**2012 Chablis - Croix Aux Moines**

Here the expressive and layered nose is composed of slightly riper white and yellow fruit aromas that also display hints of sea breeze and shellfish. There is notably better concentration as the dry extract really coats the palate and is sufficient to add a slight hint of sweetness though a noticeable saline character buffers it so the lingering finish remains clean and refreshing. This too is worth checking out though note that the style of the two wines is...

**2012 Chablis "Beauroy"**

A ripe yellow orchard fruit nose displays top notes of mineral reduction, citrus and a softly exotic character. There is fine richness to the generously proportioned and luscious medium weight flavors that also possess plenty of palate coating dry extract before terminating in a lemony and moderately dry finish where a touch of wood surfaces. This delicious effort should drink well young.

**2012 Chablis "Côte de Léchet"**

A subtle but not invisible application of wood sets off an exceptionally fresh and cool nose of ripe citrus, oyster shell and iodine aromas. There is fine mid-palate density of the mineral-inflected, detailed and attractively rich medium-bodied flavors that also display plenty of citrus character on the saline, intense, crisp and impressively persistent finish. This is one to consider.

**2012 Chablis "Fourchaume"**

A mildly exotic but still quite fresh nose offers up notes of white peach, apricot and a hint of mineral reduction. There is excellent richness to the very round and textured medium-bodied flavors that possess fine concentration before culminating in a complex and salty finish that is dry but not really austere.

**2012 Bourgogne**

There is a slightly macerated quality to the ripe and fresh aromas of kirsch, dark raspberry and earth where the latter component is picked up by the vibrant and well-detailed middle weight flavors that display a mildly rustic texture on the peppery finish. This forward "drink me young" effort is competent if not truly distinguished for its level.
