<p>2007 Domaine Denis et Isabelle Pommier Chablis Beauroy (\$40) Straw-yellow. Subtle aromas of lemon, lime and powdered stone. Juicy and intense, with good mineral grip to the citrus and floral flavors. Riper and denser than the 2007 village wines here, with more length too, but has the energy of the vintage in spades. In fact, I prefer this to the same wine in 2006 for its greater verve. Offers lovely floral lift in the mouth.</p>	89
<p>2007 Domaine Denis et Isabelle Pommier Chablis Cote de Lechet (\$40) Pale yellow-straw. Stone and citrus fruits, a hint of mint and a steely nuance on the nose. Supple on entry, then saline and quite dry in the middle, conveying an impression of volume without weight. This is quite inexpressive and youthfully tight now, with a solid stony underpinning, and in need of aging. Quite lemony on the back end, and not yet showing the length of the Beauroy.</p>	88(+?)
